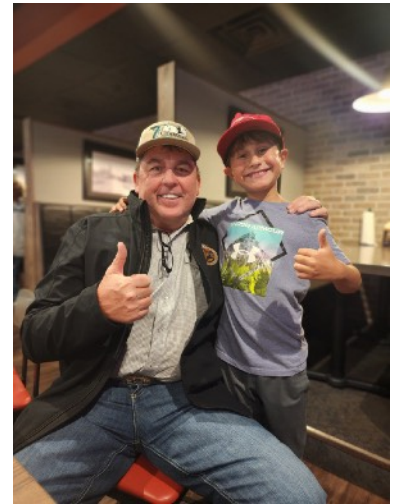
Oscar Cantu with a Fields of Faith leader and student who gave her life to Christ!
